The Democratic Republican party of Germany has issued an address to the people of the United States, which we find translated in the New York Tribune. This address may be regarded as one of the most important documents of the age, and shows that the Republican principle in Germany has taken deep root in the minds and hearts of the people. The German Democracy do not appeal to the passions or prejudices of mankind; but purpose to effect the social and political regeneration of their country by pacific means. They bring reason, not force, to their aid. The following extract—the whole address being too long for us to publish—will be read with interest:
