MURDER AND ATTEMPTED SUICIDE. A great sensation was created yesterday afternoon by a report of a dreadful murder having been committed in a house in Baronne street, between Julia and Girod streets, occupied by a woman named King, and the murderer had attempted to commit suicide immediately after penetrating the homicide.

HEALTH OF ST. LOUIS. During the week ending Monday the 26th ult., there were sixty-nine deaths in the city of St. Louis, twenty-four of which number were children of the age of five years and under.

FIRE. The dwelling of Mr. Richard Crosswell, near Columbia, Boone county, Mo., was destroyed by fire on the 24th ult. A good deal of the clothing of the family and many articles of value were consumed. No insurance... In Glasgow, week before last, the dwelling house of the Rev. Wm.
