AUSTRIAN CIVILIZATION.—The Vienna papers report the abasement of two ladies of rank, who sat at the Emperor's feet in a contemptuous and unbecoming manner. They were arrested, tried and whipped. Upon this London paper remarks: "It may be a question whether or not the representative of these women-floggers ought to be received at the court of a queen on the same footing as the representatives of civilized nations. At all events no man of any decent or honorable feeling can henceforth mix in his society, and the ladies, of course, must in self-defence avoid him."

Sugar Manufacture.

In a commercial article of the New York Courier and Enquirer, we find the following translation from the Courrier des Etats Unis: "IMPORTANT DISCOVERY.—The Paris Monitor of the 23d July, publishes officially the report of M. Lajoussie, on the discovery of a Belgian chemist, M. Melsens, a pupil of M. Dumas, of a process by which the best and the sugar cane can be made to yield up the totality of the saccharine matter they contain, and whereby sugar of a superior quality can be obtained, without the intervention of the cumbersome and expensive machinery now required in the manufacture of beet-root sugar, and in refineries."

If this discovery, loudly insisted on by men of science, should turn out as anticipated, the product from beet would be increased one-third, and that from the cane one-half, and moreover, all the apparatus, except that for the trituration or grinding, and that for purifying the juices, would be dispensed with.

"In the presence of such an imminent revolution," says the report, "all operations connected with the manufacture of sugar are suspended, and cannot again their accustomed course, until public opinion shall be satisfied as to the merits of the alleged discovery. The Minister proposed the appointment by the President of a Committee to verify the results, and this was accordingly done, with the understanding that if the report of such a Committee should be favorable, a recommendation should be made to the Assembly to buy for the State, the right of the discoverer, to the end that it be made public."

The Committee is composed of nine representatives, two or three sugar manufacturers, the head of the Customs, the Directors of the Colonies, the Chief Assistant in the Ministry of Commerce, and some others—M. Dumas being the Chairman.

These experiments on the new method, were to be made forth with before the Committee, the first, purely scientific, were to take place in the laboratory of M. Dumas—the second the sugar works of M. Barin, a member of the Committee, to test its utility in the manufacturing point of view—and the third, at the great estates of M. Clap, at Valenciennes, where the proceedings were to be on a very large scale.

A letter addressed to the Independent (newspaper) gives these details. "The discovery of M. Melsens is of the most grave and serious import for all the interests, whether colonial or at home, connected with the manufacture of sugar.

The realisation of this discovery, and the decomposition and separation of the portion of the plant containing the saccharine is accomplished—and the distillation which takes place without any other process—the sugar is purified, the filtering, the boiling, and I had almost said, the skimming are dispensed with. The new process applies to the sugar-plant—the cuttings, presses, and even the boilers for purifying the juice are still needed—but the sugar, once purified, is ready for use. M. Melsens' process, with a single pinch of the marvellous substance which remains the secret of the inventor—brings about in a few minutes the clearing and the crystallization of the saccharine matters. Good, therefore, to refine with their slow and costly process, within seven quarters of an hour, may be produced a loaf of the whitest and purest sugar.

The correspondent may well add, as he does, supporting his version of the effects of this discovery to be correct, "it is impossible to conceive, or to calculate, the consequences of this new process."

The sugar growers and the sugar refiners in the United States—in both which branches large capitals and expensive processes are employed—will doubtless look early into this alleged discovery, which seems too marvellous.

MACAULAY'S HISTORY.—A review of Mr. Macaulay's History of England appears in the last number of the Edinburgh Review. It has no rank in New Orleans, and we cannot therefore speak of it from our own reading. The New York Courier and Enquirer, however, pronounces it "calm, dispassionate, unpretending, and yet glowing in sentiment and in admiration of its object, it is evidently written by some one with whom criticism is not a trade and who is yet master of its art." The authorship is, by an English journal, attributed to Lord Dover. The Edinburgh reviewer reviews the Quarterly on Macaulay, and thus sums up Mr. Croker's criticism on the History:

We have only given our readers some means of estimating, as the well-informed among them could easily have done without our help, how far the critic has succeeded in the very humble object of pointing out errors.
