CAREFOL—John Davis, a well known grocer, was accommodated with snug quarters yesterday for thirty days, on the charge of being a dangerous and suspicious character.

DISORDERLY HOUSE.—The case of Jenny O'Brien came up again yesterday, and further testimony was adduced to show that her beer-house in Barzak street is generally disorderly to a degree not allowed by the ordinance.

ARRESTS.—The following arrests were made yesterday: Daniel Hurley, charged with a petty theft; James Thompson, for robbing Michael McDermott of his pocket-book containing \$35; Wm. Jones, accused of creating a riot on the levee.

DISCHARGED.—Elizabeth Dunn, a free woman of color, was examined yesterday before Recorder Baldwin, on the charge of arson in setting fire to her residence in Poydras street. The evidence did not sustain the affidavit, and the accused was accordingly discharged.

A REVELATION.—John Carroll, ambitious of operating in cotton without risking capital—quite a common operation on the levee—concluded to take the legitimate course of business and take advantage of the present high rates of the market.

THE \$2500 ROBBERY.—Daniel Smith, one of the number arrested on suspicion of robbing young Fernandez of \$2500, on the 19th inst., was brought up for examination yesterday before Recorder Genois. Fernandez identified the accused as being the man in the crowd that pushed against him when he entered the bank. The accused was committed to take his trial before the First District Court.

ANOTHER SAMSON.—Patrick McDermott, indicted on duty by our report of the wondrous feat performed in "carrying away" a horse and dray from the levee, attempted, at least so it is alleged, to emulate the example of his illustrious predecessor by saying that property name kind, belonging to John Cavanna. The humor, however, was greater than he could bear, and the act led to his arrest yesterday by the Second Municipal Police.

FATAL ATTEMPT.—An Italian, a fruiterer in the Dryades Market, was killed about 5 o'clock last evening, on the levee, off of Girod street, by an Irishman, named Welch, a levee trader. The dispute arose about a lot of eggs, which they were bargaining for; when the Italian drew a knife and attacked Welch, who retreated backwards several steps, during which time he received a wound in the hand which nearly severed the thumb, but succeeded ultimately in getting the knife from his opponent, when he stabbed him in the back of the shoulder, the knife penetrating through the breast. He gave the knife up.

QUITE ROMANTIC.—Who has not read of the devotion of the wife of Lavlette? and who has not perused romances without number where exciting scenes were wrought from the same basis? The story is so old, yet so interesting in real life at Baton Rouge a short time since, when one Lewis Dixon escaped from the prison of his cell in his wife's clothes, who remained in his place to bear the frowns of the law, while the culprit extended the area of his freedom as fast as steam could carry him. Dixon, or Williams, for he has both appellations, was arrested there on the charge of being concerned in a very heavy robbery of jewelry, and we must spoil the affecting incident of his escape by saying that there was little doubt of his guilt. The wife, however, showed the true woman; but her effort to save the prisoner proved of little avail, for he was so imprudent as to show himself yesterday to the piercing eyes of officer Boutwell, who immediately took the offender into custody. Dixon will remain in confinement until he is delivered up to the authorities of Baton Rouge for trial.

THIRD MUNICIPALITY.—The "Old Thel" was particularly dull yesterday. The weather exerted a gloomy influence even upon the locomotive which keeps up signs of life in Elysian Fields street—it finally gave forth its note of preparation, to take the track, and proceeded most leisurely upon its way.

THE CASE BEFORE Recorder Senzani consisted of the following: Henry Shepard, Hugh Morgan, Terrance Morgan, Peter Keenan, and Patrick Tobin, were brought up on the charge of having robbed Mr. McKewen of \$35. The evidence was sufficient to commit the prisoners for trial before the First District Court. Owen Keenan and James Thompson, arrested on the same charge, were set at liberty.

Joseph Smith and Patrick Hayes were fined \$5 each, for departing from an upright course, by imbibing any quantity of the article known as rum.

John McCabe and Ann Reilly were sent to the Workhouse for thirty days.

FIFTH DISTRICT COURT.—Daryl A. Dymally vs. Bark Cores and Owners.—This was an action brought for the recovery of the value of two pipes of heavy, shipped by Sturgess, Bennett & Co. of New York, to the plaintiffs, and consigned to this port and delivered empty, the contents having leaked out on the passage. The Port Wardens were called upon to make a survey of the damages, and the certificate granted by them went to show that in consequence of the improper stowage the casks were fattened at the bilges and the seams forced open at the heads and chimes. That it was evident, from appearances, that they were retained in good order, and sufficiently strong when shipped to support any ordinary pressure of cargo during the transportation, if the necessary stowage had been used; but that the leakage was caused by the pressure of the cargo in the absence of the necessary caulking to support the casks. The action was brought for the recovery of the brassy and costs of survey, and a requisition was granted against the defendants. The defendants plead a general denial of all the allegations set forth in the petition of the plaintiffs. The judgment of the court was rendered against the defendants for the sum of \$189 75, with privilege on the property sequestered.

WHOLESALE HIGHWAY ROBBERY.—Samuel Livingston was examined yesterday before Recorder Genois, on the charge of knocking down and robbing Henry S. Russell, on the night of the 23d inst. Russell stated in evidence that on Saturday evening he was enjoying himself in the Eagle Ball room, at the corner of Freemen and Victory streets; that he became so much interested in the amusement, and elated by imbibing a half-dozen punches, that the hours flew by, on pleasure's wings, until after the winking time of twelve. While debating whether to protract the carousal or to seek his coach, the accused (Livingston) offered him services to assist in a doubtful vision, and the impressed upon complainant's mind the necessity of receiving the aid of a friend to protect him from the dangers of the city. Russell accepted the proffered escort, and the pair proceeded to the levee to find the boat on which the unphilosophical individual was borne from his verdant home to the dust of New Orleans. When near the ferry landing of the Third Municipality, the false friend suddenly turned upon Russell, knocked him down, and deliberately stripped him of his coat, boots, hat, and every article of raiment except the one thing needful, which he left in his tender mercy to protect the shivering stranger from the rude blasts of night. Twenty dollars in cash was also part of the booty acquired by the insatiate rogue. Vanly, however, was the rising passion with Livingston, who could not resist the temptation of arraying himself in the garments of the victim. His evil genius prompted him to promenade in Chinatown street the day after the robbery! He soon attracted the attention of the police, who, despite his fine features, knew him to be a bird of prey, and accordingly placed him in a cage to take his trial before the Criminal Court.

SEVERAL LUMINOUS APPEARANCES.—Capt. Purkin, arrived at New York, from Porto Cabello, reports that on the 12th of February, in latitude 14°10' and longitude 64°50', at 8 o'clock p. m., he observed a luminous appearance in the heavens, resembling a large ball of fire, about ten feet in diameter. It appeared in the west, moving eastward, rather slowly, and was in sight a little more than a minute. It appeared to travel about ten degrees high, and during its continuance the lanterns were illumined with a brightness nearly equal to that of day. When disappearing it broke into a thousand fragments.
