

Municipal Officers.
Under this title, the Delia of yesterday examined the law relating to the powers of the Council and the Recorder. By a resolution of 1837, the Council select the officers on the first Tuesday of May, which is the 7th. The Recorder has the casting vote in all cases. The new Recorder takes his seat on the second Monday of May, which will be the 13th. The Council consist of 9 Whigs and 7 Democrats. Of the 16 members, 10 are Whigs and will not return in time to be at the election; there will be a tie of 7 to 7. Recorder Baldwin in the chair, with his casting vote, decides the elections. The Delia then proceeds to say, that if the Democrats abstain themselves from the regular meeting on Tuesday, Mr. Baldwin cannot, by his vote, elect Whig officers. We hope for the honor of Council no such attempt will be made, by a selfish neglect of duty, to thwart the will of the majority. But, says the Delia, if the Democrats adopt this course at the first meeting, and thus prevent a quorum, the Whigs will follow their example at the second meeting. It seems that if any Aldermen of the two successive sittings, shall leave their seats, the Council shall provide for filling the vacancy. The Delia thinks that a sitting does not necessarily mean a quorum; so that if, at the expiration of three sittings, the seven who do meet and who do not constitute a quorum, may decide that the other seven have lost their seats! The Delia has certainly studied the subject very carefully. But it is to be hoped that the party will follow these suggestions. If one party disregard their duties, and refuse to attend the offices to which they have been elected, the other party will, as a matter of necessity, do the same thing. Let us make a calculation. The Whigs hold a "sitting" on Tuesday the 7th; the Democrats absent themselves. The Democrats meet, and there are no Whigs present—there is no quorum. On the 22d, the Whigs again are absent, and there is no quorum. Thus the action of the Council is paralyzed until June 1st. By that time the two absentees will have returned, and then after a lapse of a month there will be a Council.
