

FOREIGN NEWS.

We have full details of the foreign news received by the Hibernia, which arrived at Boston on the 17th inst. Below we give all of its importance:

The most striking event of the week is the birth of another royal prince, which took place at Buckingham Palace on the morning of Wednesday last.

London is apparently increasing in healthiness every day. The deaths returned for the week which ended the 4th inst. were 803, the births 1,429. There was no case of cholera reported.

The Liverpool Times says:—The moral power of the Ministry seems every day to be waning. On Thursday night Sir F. Thurgis left in a minority, reducing the majority of the Ministry to the duty on Sir F's certificates.

The Observer newspaper hints at strong symptoms of division in the Protectionist party in the House of Commons.

DEATH OF REV. RICHARD REECE.—The English papers announce the death of the venerable Rev. Richard Reece, an eminent minister of the 85th year of his age.

The Vienna Gazette announces that diplomatic relations have been resumed with the Porte.

A correspondence is now in progress between the Emperor and the King of Prussia, respecting the candidature of the Countess of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha.

The Parliament at Berlin is prorogued on the 25th inst., "having rendered that co-operation in the work of constituting the German Union which is required by the Emperor and King of Prussia."
