NEW ORLEANS MARKETS.

Business has fallen off since Monday, and transactions in our market have generally been on quite a limited scale. The delay of the Canada's advance order unfavorably on our market...

Unless some unusual delay should be experienced, we may in a day or two look for telegraphic advices from Europe to be followed 100 or 150 days later, by the arrival of one of the California steamers at New York...

They further provide that compensation of postmasters shall not be greater than that for the preceding year, and that the provisions allowing newspapers delivered within thirty miles of the place where published to be free, and that 50 per cent of the postage on magazines to be deducted from the pre-paid amount...

Letters remaining in post-offices for six weeks, instead of two, to be advertised, to be published only once, at a charge of one cent on each letter called for...

The provisions taking away the benefits of exchange, if the publisher refusing to publish the list, is stricken out.

The seventh section is stricken out. They report two additional sections, one granting to the publishers of newspapers, pamphlets, periodicals and magazines, to interchange one copy of their publications, and to enclose, in publications, bills for subscriptions, free of postage...

The Senate took up the bill for the relief of the Virginia Wool Company, and after a debate, it was postponed.

The Senate then took up the bill to settle private claims in California.

The question presented was on an amendment making the patent issued to claimant by the U. S. Court, as relinquishing the U. S. title only. After a debate, it was rejected.

Mr. Houston offered an amendment extending to the claims for land the law of prescription.

Upon this debate ceased, and without taking the vote, the Senate adjourned.
