Division of the State. The Southern Convention for the division of the State was to have been held on Monday, the 20th.

Outrages at Stockton. Stockton, in the early part of this month, (Oct.), became the scene of outrages of a similar character to those which, some time since, disgraced San Francisco.

Mormons in California. The Mormons have at length taken possession of the rancho of San Bernardino, near Los Angeles.

Labors in California. The agricultural, mining, and commercial interests are in the full tide of prosperous career.

Steamboat Burnt. The steamer "Merrill" was burnt by fire, last week, while entering the New Bay, near the Slough, just below New York.

From China. Intelligence has been received at San Francisco from Hong Kong of the 24 of August, by the ship Hecker, fifty-seven days from Whampoa.

From the Sandwich Islands. An attempt is again being made to establish communication between the Sandwich Islands and the continent.

San Francisco Items. The debt of San Francisco, outstanding on the first of May last, has been found to be the amount of \$1,300,000.

From Oregon. We have dates to the 7th ult. It is estimated that the emigration this year to Oregon across the plains will be not less than 6000 souls.

Gold in Oregon.

Gold has been found near Saddle Mountain, which lies along the base of the Coast Range, in the north of the Columbia river, it being about fifty miles south-east of Astoria.

One year ago there was but one gold mine in Oregon, the Columbia; now there are eleven steamboats of different kinds running in the Columbia and Willamette rivers.

Gov. Gaines has left the Territory, and is now, probably, in the United States. An agricultural and mineral fair is to be held in San Francisco on the 20th inst.

In regard to the Sonora Expedition, spoken of by the Mexican papers, a Los Angeles paper says: It will be remembered that in May last a company of forty men passed through this city.

The men arrived at the mouth of the Colorado river, having been absent about five months. The rest of the party, excepting one who has died, are on their way hither.

At some places the Mexicans mistook them for Morehead and his party, regarding those contemplated expedition they had heard of.

We find in the Herald the following communication dated Jackson, Calaveras county, Oct. 4, 1851: Great excitement exists here just now, caused by the discovery of rich and extensive diggings in the mountains near Jackson.

About two months ago, a company of twelve laid claim to a quartz lode, on a hill a mile and a half from Jackson, and have ever since been digging.

The party driven off went among the miners in the vicinity of Jackson, and were very successful.

The weather, throughout Oregon and Upper and Lower California, is certainly the most favorable and more smiling aspect under an Italian sky.

The new vessel, the "Whaling fleet" in the Arctic, has been confirmed by subsequent arrivals. It will be seen from our columns, that a great number of vessels have been lost, and the success of the whaling fleet is not so successful.

The eruption of Volcano. We learn from a gentleman just returned from Hawaii, that the action in the crater on Mauna Loa, noticed last week, has resulted in an extensive eruption of molten lava.

Affairs upon the isthmus do not look favorable to American life or property. A prominent New Granadaian journal has decided that American cannot constitute any other than a New Granadaian territory.

On Sunday morning, through Gregory & Co.'s Express, sent forward with its usual despatch by a larger and more commodious steamer than any other.

On yesterday the Herald appended containing a copy, in which it is stated that from twenty to thirty American were killed, and over one hundred natives.

It is stated that Gov. Diaz will leave here to-day or to-morrow, at the head of 100 of the National Guard, for the purpose of restoring peace and order at Chagres.

The Boatmen's Club of Chagres have for some time past obtained the exclusive privilege (which was not recognized by the inhabitants) of taking passengers to and from American steamers.

Some natives and a large number of blacks from the District of Columbia, carried passengers to and from the steamer "Boat" which arrived without molestation.

They marched down the town and shot a man opposite the Consul's office. The Consul attempted to arrest the blacks and was fired at himself, and obliged to retire within his office.

The inhabitants, who were quite unprepared, fled in confusion, and after a brief struggle, and possession for about an hour, retired to the other side of the river.
