New York. A large four-story building No. 4 Fletcher street, occupied by Penfold & Co., Drugists, and also the buildings Nos. 214 and 216 Pearl street, occupied by Messrs. Bunting and Foots, Paper Warehouse; of Shivers & Co., Auctioneers; E. S. Holmes, Hardware Merchant, and G. Haviland, Storage Merchant, were entirely consumed by fire on the 27th. The loss is not yet definitely ascertained, but can hardly fall short of \$500,000.

Coosa River. An movement is on foot in the Legislature of Georgia, to obtain an appropriation for the purpose of improving the navigation of so much of the Coosa River as flows through Georgia. At certain seasons the Coosa River is navigable for about one hundred and seventy-five miles, of which about one-third is within the boundaries of Georgia. The obstructions which the petitioners desire to have removed, consist of gravelly and rocky shoals—the most formidable of which is about one mile and a half below Rome.
