Some FARM REMEDIES. (From St. Louis Republic.) SASTONENE is a good remedy for worms in horses.

NEWLY-SLACKED lime is a good disinfectant to use about the pig-pen. It is cheap and can be used liberally.

ONE ounce of tannic acid, glycerine two ounces, applied with a sponge two or three times a day, is a good remedy for galled shoulders on horses.

FLOR or fine middlings 10 pounds, powdered gentian one pound, sulphate of iron four ounces; mix all together and a half pint daily is a good tonic to give sheep affected with liver rot.

TOBACCO, 8 pounds; oil of tar, 1 pint; soda ash, 10 pounds; water, 30 gallons. Boil down to 20 gallons and dip the sheep in, allowing them to stand three or four minutes. This is a good remedy for scab.

Twelve ounces of opium salts, 20 croton beans and a drachm of calomel mixed with about two quarts of limseed oilmeal grease, is a good remedy to give cows suffering with dry murrain.
