**COUNCIL HALL.**  
COVINGTON, LA., Feb. 5, 1895.  
The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on the above date.  
**Present.**—Adolph Frederick, Mayor; Dr. C. Z. Williams, S. D. Anderson, Hardy H. Smith, J. A. Parley, L. Roubion, A. Laborde.  
The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.  
The committee to attend to the opening of the streets, asked further time to report, which was granted, until next meeting.  
It was moved by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Roubion, that Mr. Erwin, having rented the lower floor of the Town Hall for a week, be allowed the use of the same for \$2.50 per night. Carried.  
On motion, duly seconded, the Mayor appointed the following committee to confer with Mr. John Poitevent, in regard to the purchase of the lots adjoining the Cemetery, for the purpose of enlarging the same:  
Hardy H. Smith, S. D. Anderson and Adolph Laborde.  
On motion of Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Parley, the Mayor appointed the following committee to draw plans and submit the probable cost of a town jail, and report at the next meeting: Dr. C. Z. Williams, Hardy H. Smith, J. A. Parley.  
On motion, duly seconded, all persons having alleys and streets fenced in, were granted further time, till the 20th of February, to open the same, and the Marshal is hereby instructed to open all alleys and streets that are not opened on that date. Carried.  
On motion, the Marshal was instructed to make a report of collections of fines, etc., at every meeting.

Lockett, 1 drill 30 cts. 4 bolts 20 cents total, \$1.16. J. E. Smith, to making, hanging and painting one small gate at Cemetery, \$1.70; lumber furnished, 25 cts; hinges 15 cts; one hatch 5 cts; nails 10 cts; one chain, staples and weight, 40 cts; four padlocks for large gate, \$1.00; repairing fastenings on large gate, 25 cts; total, \$2.90. Total amount bills approved, \$6.85. On motion, the Council in adjourned.

**A SUPPOSED MURDERER ARRESTED.**  
The Daily States of last Monday says:  
Dan Usher, alias Jack, alias Washington, a young negro, was arrested this morning by the second precinct by Officers Jackson and Connolly and locked up charged with being a fugitive from justice from St. Tammany Parish, where he was wanted for murder.  
It is alleged that some months ago Usher foully murdered a Syrian peddler for the purpose of robbery on the outskirts of Floreville. Last week Sheriff Stroble, of Covington, was in the city searching for the negro, but could find no trace of him. A message for Usher's arrest together with his description was sent to all stations and this morning the officers placed him under arrest while he was at work laying tracks for the Traction Company on Chippewa street.  
The prisoner was seen by a reporter of the States and he readily admitted that he was Usher, the man wanted, but denies any knowledge of the crime with which he is charged. He declares his utter ignorance of the fact of the murder and states that some weeks ago he learned that he was wanted for murder and surrendered to Sheriff McMichael and the Sheriff said that he would communicate with the authorities and if he was wanted would let him know by letter. Usher says that he went to Hammond and then came to this city. Thus far he has not heard from Mr. McMichael. The prisoner stated that some three months ago he worked for the light-house tender at Madisonville, but says he never set foot in Floreville, which is a short distance away.  
Officer Jackson swore out an affidavit against Usher and he was remanded to await the action of the authorities of St. Tammany Parish. Chief Gaster has sent a telegram to Sheriff Stroble.
