




EXCELLENT PIGGERY.

The silo is not omnipotent; it does not hold the balance of power between success and failure of the careless, lazy farmer.


THE SUPPLY OF HOGS. It is somewhat below demand at Present and Prospects for the Future Are Promising.

A BARN ROOF PLAN. Although Unsupported by Posts Its Construction is Strong Enough to Stand Any Strain.

This plan of barn roof is without posts in mow to support the roof. The roof is supported by four braces (c c c), which extend from each corner of the barn to the center of the roof at the top.

BARN ROOF WITHOUT POSTS. to prevent braces springing sideways. The purlin braces (b b), are spiked to the four braces so that the tops of the plates will be even with tops of braces.


