Police Jury.

Covington, La., April 13, 1903. The Police Jury met on the above date and remained in session two days.

Present—First ward—Geo. Koepf, Jr. Second ward—Wm. Bruhl. Third ward—G. C. Alexius. Fourth ward—Jos. M. Smith. Fifth ward—Crawford Williams. Sixth ward—H. Q. Parker. Seventh ward—John A. Todd. Eighth ward—John Swinson. Ninth ward—W. E. Gause.

On motion, duly seconded, the minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. On motion, duly seconded, the President appointed the following committee to visit Bogus Chitto River and select a site for the proposed new bridge.

It was moved, and duly seconded, that a committee be appointed to petition the National Waterways Convention for an appropriation of \$50,000 for the Bogus Chitto river and \$20,000 for the Bogus Falls, Carried.

The President appointed on said committee Messrs. J. S. Jones, F. Jalneke, P. F. Herwig, A. Salmen, C. Z. Williams, Geo. Koepf, Jr., H. R. Warren and T. E. Brewster.

The following petitions were read: To the honorable president and members of the Police Jury. Gentlemen—We, the undersigned taxpayers and property holders, petition your honorable body to make the following change in our road, (the Pierre road.)

Said change to be as follows: To leave the present road at north end of W. T. Wallis' lane and through south of N. Fendlasson's land over the new graded road by G. M. Fendlasson and via W. H. Mathies' place and connect again at the Police bridge on the Tchoufouets river.

Said change will give a much nearer and direct route from said Police bridge to Covington, and besides, all the low and bad places are now thrown up and bridged.

Gentlemen—We, the undersigned property holders and residents of the Ninth Ward, owning property or living along or near the proposed road hereinafter described, respectfully petition your honorable body to grant us thirty foot public road from the southern limits of Slidell, La., to the marsh south of Guzman Switch, La.

This said road connecting at City limits with the street in Slidell which runs north and south in front of Salmen's store, and from the City limits to the marsh being bounded on the west by the right of way of the New Orleans and North Eastern Railroad. The undersigned property owners dedicate thirty feet right of way for the purposes of said road bed.
