CHARTER

Peace and Goodwill Benevolent Association.

United States of America, State of Louisiana, Parish of St. Tammany.

BE IT KNOWN, That on this twenty-ninth day of the month of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three...

ARTICLE I. The name and title of this Corporation shall be and is hereby fixed at Covington, in the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana...

ARTICLE II. The objects and purposes for which this Corporation and Association is established are hereby declared to be for the giving of mutual aid and assistance to all the members of this Association...

ARTICLE III. The objects and purposes for which this Corporation and Association is established are hereby declared to be for the giving of mutual aid and assistance to all the members of this Association...

ARTICLE IV. All the corporate powers of this Corporation shall be and are hereby invested in the following officers: A President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer and Grand Marshal...

ARTICLE V. Any person of good moral character over the age of eighteen years and under sixty years of age shall be eligible to membership in this corporation.

ARTICLE VI. This Corporation and Association shall exist and continue for the period of ninety-nine years from the date hereof, unless sooner dissolved by a majority vote of all members in good standing...

ARTICLE VII. A reward is offered by the undersigned for any party or parties caught trespassing or cutting any timber on my land, (known as the Crossman's land) situated three miles from Abita Springs...
