

Drummers Go to Law to Have Bed Sheets Changed.

Columbus, Ga., Feb. 8.—Georgia traveling men have begun a "clean sheet" crusade by drafting a bill, which one of the members of the Travelers' Protective Association, who is a member of the Legislature, will introduce, requiring hotel keepers to change the bed linen before assigning the room to a new guest. It is claimed that in some of the smaller towns the sheets are changed but once a week, no matter how many persons occupy the bed in that time.

The specialists are not yet agreed as to the food value of sugar, but the consumption of sugar as food advances by leaps and bounds. A French scientist, discussing this interesting question under the pen name of "Dr. Ox," mentions the

interesting fact that since the lowering of the price of sugar the consumption of it has increased over 500,000,000 kilos a year.
