

A strip of flannel or towel folded several times lengthwise and dipped in hot water, then slightly wrung out and applied about the neck of a child suffering with an acute attack of croup, will usually relieve the sufferer in the course of ten minutes, if the flannel is kept hot. There is no domestic remedy that so promptly cuts short congestion of the lungs, sore throat and rheumatism as will hot water, when applied promptly and thoroughly.
