Reasons for Unpainted Barns.

A Philadelphia paint dealer gives a peculiar reason for the number of unpainted barns to be seen in the rural districts. He says that because taxes are higher on painted structures the farmer often refuses to paint any of his outbuildings, despite the fact that paint to preserve the life of such structures is cheaper than the lumber and carpenter work needed to put up a new one. The fact seems to be that the average rural tax assessor never notices an unpainted barn, but as soon as it is painted it strikes him as an improvement, and he raises the valuation to such a point that the farmer, who knows the situation, decides not to paint.

Floods and cold weather have caused widespread damage in Louisiana and Mississippi. Heavy rains have caused numerous washouts and carried away many bridges. The cold weather has caused great loss to the trucking industry.
