CHARTER OF THE SMITH HARDWARE CO., LTD.
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.
Parish of St. Tammany.
BE IT KNOWN, That on this, the 1st day of April, 1910, a certain number of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten, and of the Independence of the United States the One Hundred and thirty-fourth.
Before me, EDWARD H. RICHARD, a Notary Public duly commissioned and sworn to, in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and in the presence of the witnesses hereinafter named and sworn to, who personally came and appeared the parties whose names are hereunto subscribed, all of full age, sane mind, and of legal age, themselves of the provisions of the laws of the State of Louisiana, relative to the organization of corporations, they have declared and agreed, and by these presents do covenant and agree to bind themselves, as well as such other persons and corporations, to become associated with them, to form and constitute a corporation and body politic in law, to be known as the SMITH HARDWARE CO., LTD., and under the stipulations, articles and conditions following, to-wit:
ARTICLE I.
The name and style of this corporation shall be the SMITH HARDWARE COMPANY, LIMITED, and by that name it shall have power and authority to exist and enjoy successions, and to sue and be sued, and to hold real and personal property for a term of not more than ninety-nine years from date hereof, unless sooner dissolved.
ARTICLE II.
The domicile of this corporation shall be in the Town of Covington, in the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana. All citations and other legal processes shall be served upon the President and the Secretary of this corporation, or in their absence, upon the President and the Secretary of the Board of Directors and stockholders.
ARTICLE III.
The objects and purposes for which this corporation is established, and the nature of the business to be carried on by it, are hereby declared to be: To do a general wholesale and retail hardware and building material business, and to manufacture and sell glassware, crockery, and other articles, and to do such other business as may be deemed necessary to carry on the objects and purposes of this corporation.
ARTICLE IV.
This corporation shall be or be used in its corporate name, make or be used a corporate seal, the same to be used and break at any time, and to be used to purchase, convey, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, lease, sub-lease, and convey real, personal or mixed property, or any estate in and money and make contracts; make and establish such by-laws, rules and regulations as may be necessary, and the same to change and alter at pleasure; and shall possess all the rights and privileges to which corporations are or may be authorized and entitled to possess. This corporation may exercise its corporate powers within any other State or States.
ARTICLE V.
The capital stock of said corporation shall be Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars, divided into and represented by two hundred (200) shares of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each, which said stock shall be subscribed for in the following manner: Not less than ten (10) shares in cash, and the balance to be paid for in installments, the same to be issued at not less than par, in payment on exchange for property, rights, claims, or claims received or purchased by said corporation, or the same may be issued, full paid, for money advanced and for such other valuable consideration as may be determined by the Board of Directors of said corporation, or said shares of stock may be signed by the President and Secretary, at all elections by the stockholders, each share of stock shall be entitled to one vote to be cast by the person whose name is on the books of the corporation, or by his agent or proxy, duly authorized to that effect in writing, and the same to be a going concern as soon as the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars is subscribed for.
ARTICLE VI.
No stockholder shall have the authority or right to sell or otherwise dispose of his stock in part without first giving the Board of Directors fifteen (15) days' notice of his intention or desire to dispose of any of his stock or a part thereof, and allowing the Board of Directors, or in its default, any stockholder, the first opportunity of purchasing the stock. Any stock so sold or disposed of shall be held under the above conditions, provided such transferee makes an affidavit before said corporation at its office at Covington, in the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and the surrender of the certificate therefor; the Board of Directors shall have the right to determine how much stock shall be issued.
ARTICLE VII.
The business affairs and corporate powers of this corporation shall be transacted by a Board of Directors to be composed of four (4) stockholders. No person shall be eligible as a director or officer as herein provided in this charter, who is not a stockholder in this corporation.
The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by a majority of the stockholders present at a meeting to be held for that purpose each year. The following named persons, to-wit: J. B. ARTICLE VIII.
Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors, from any cause, shall be filled by the Board of Directors, or by a majority of the Board of Directors, from among the stockholders of the corporation; three (3) of whom shall constitute a quorum thereof, unless otherwise provided by the Board of Directors.
The Board of Directors shall make such by-laws, rules and regulations as they may deem necessary, and change and alter the same, and may also appoint or remove any officers and employees, with their salaries, term of service, with power to discontinue the same at the pleasure of said Board. And said Board shall have the right to determine and assign the duties of all officers and employees herein provided for, and to alter or change the same at any time.
This act of incorporation may be changed, modified or amended, or said corporation may be dissolved with the consent of a majority of the amount of the authorized capital stock, as provided in this charter, and in the event of the death or disability of any one of said commissioners, the survivors shall continue to act.
ARTICLE IX.
No stockholder of this corporation shall ever be held liable or responsible for the contracts or debts thereof, in any manner, or for the unpaid balance due the corporation on the shares subscribed for or owned by him, or for any liability of the corporation, which have the effect of rendering this charter null, or exposing a stockholder to any liability for the unpaid balance, if any, of his stock.
