

LICENSE ORDINANCE.
Be it ordained by the police jury
of the parish of St. Tammany, La.,
That a license be and is hereby levied
for the year 1912 upon each per-
son, corporation, firm or association
pursuing any occupation, business or
calling carried on or conducted in
the parish subject to a State license
is hereby fixed at the same as is now
levied by the State for such trade, oc-
cupation, business or calling in this
parish except the liquor license,
which shall be Five Hundred Dollars.
Sec. 2. Be it further ordained,
etc. That the amount of license due
this parish for each trade, occupa-
tion, business or calling carried on
or conducted in the parish subject
to a license is hereby fixed at the
same as is now levied and collected
by the State for such trade, occupa-
tion, business or calling in this par-
ish, except the liquor license, which
shall be Five Hundred Dollars.
Sec. 3. Be it further ordained,
etc. That the license due this parish
shall be and are hereby due and col-
lectible at the same time, and in the
same manner as the license due the
State, and in the event the same are
not paid when due it is ordered that
the tax collector report the same to
his attorney, who is hereby author-
ized and instructed to forthwith
institute legal proceedings to en-
force the payment of the same.

that the above ordinance be adopted.
