

**ELECTION PROCLAMATION.**

Twenty-Sixth Judicial District Court, Parish of St. Tammany, Louisiana.

Whereas, it is provided by an act of the General Assembly of the State of Louisiana, approved March 30, 1870, said act being the charter of the town of Covington, La., and amended by the Town Council of said town by ordinance adopted April 20, 1915, in accordance with section 43 of Act 136 of 1898 of the General Assembly of the State of Louisiana, that an election shall be held on the Tuesday next following the third Monday in June for the year 1915, and for each following second year thereafter, by the qualified electors of the town of Covington, St. Tammany parish, La., for the purpose of electing one Mayor, six Aldermen, one Day Marshal and one Night Marshal, of the said town at large, to serve as such for the ensuing twenty-four months thereafter, and it being the duty of the Clerk of Court of said parish to call said election,

Now, therefore, I, E. J. Frederick, clerk of the court for the parish of St. Tammany, La., in compliance with the said act, the charter of the town of Covington, amended as aforesaid, to issue this notice, notifying all persons concerned to hold said election on

Tuesday, June 22, 1915, . . . . . being the Tuesday next following the third Monday in said month, with the view of electing the above named officers. Said election to be conducted and the returns made in the manner required by the laws of the State of Louisiana, as embodied in said charter as amended.

The polls will open at 10 o'clock a. m. and close at 4 o'clock p. m.
