Notice is hereby given that a general meeting of the stockholders of the St. Tammany Bank & Trust Company will be held at its banking house at Covington, Louisiana, on May 19th, 1917, for the purpose of taking the sense of the stockholders upon the proposition of altering and amending Articles 1, 2 and 3 of its charter, as follows, to-wit:

1st. To amend Article 1 of said charter in order to change the name of the corporation from the St. Tammany Bank & Trust Company to the Saint Tammany Bank.

2nd. To amend Article 2 of the charter of said corporation by the elimination of the powers granted to and enjoyed by it as a Trust Company under existing laws.

3d. To amend Article 3 of the said charter so as to provide for the reduction of its Capital Stock from Fifty Thousand Dollars, now divided into and represented by five hundred shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars each, to Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, divided into and represented by five hundred shares of the par value of Fifty Dollars each.

4th. To perform all other acts necessary or proper in the premises. You are hereby notified to either be present or send your proxy.




