The increasing demand for wireless operators has necessitated the training of more young men in this branch of the service. To this end provision has been made to enroll young men between the ages of seventeen and twenty-five years in the Naval Reserve Force as Landsman for Electrician Third Class Radio-student in wireless telegraphy. This rating carries pay of \$32.50 per month, together with subsistence and a liberal supply of clothing. In other words, the Navy Department agrees to pay young men the salary indicated, together with their board and clothing, who are willing to take advantage of this opportunity to learn a trade and at the same time render valuable service to their country. Under the present arrangement, those enrolled for this training are taught at the Naval Station in New Orleans until such time as they are able to receive and send as many as ten words per minute, when they are sent to Harvard University where their course is completed. To be eligible for enrollment in this radio class, one must have had at least the equivalent of two years high school training. No previous experience in telegraphy, however, is absolutely essential. Young men between the ages stipulated above desiring to enroll in the Naval Reserve for this training, or secure further information in regard to the service, will call on or communicate with Lieut. R. S. Manley, Enrolling Officer, 215 Godchaux Building, New Orleans, Louisiana.

The quality of service on a party line is largely dependent upon the co-operation of the subscribers on that line.

No subscriber should use a party line for long periods of time, to the total exclusion of others.

When a party line is found to be in use, hang up your receiver immediately. While it is off the hook conversation is interfered with.

Each neighbor on a party line is entitled to a reasonable use of the telephone service, and should not be interrupted or have the privacy of his conversation interfered with.

The Golden Rule applies with particular force to party line telephone service.


