ARTICLE V.
All of the corporate powers of this
corporation and the management and
control of its affairs shall be vested
in and exercised by a Board of Di-
rectors, composed of not less than
three or more than five stockholders,
a two-thirds majority of whom shall
constitute a quorum for the transac-
tion of the business of the corpora-
tion. The Directors shall be elected
annually by ballot by the stockhold-
ers on the first Monday of January
of each year. Each stockholder shall
be entitled in person or by proxy to
a vote for every share owned by
him, and all elections shall be held
under such rules and regulations
as may be determined by the
Board of Directors; the Directors
thus elected shall continue in office
for one year, or until their successors
have been duly elected and qualified.
No failure to elect shall be regarded
as a forfeiture of this charter; any
vacancy occurring in said Board shall
be filled by the remaining Directors
for the unexpired term.
The Board of Directors, shall, at
its first meeting after its election,
nominate out of its number a Presi-
dent, a Vice-President and a Secre-
tary-Treasurer; said Board shall
have the right to appoint and dis-
miss clerks, managers and other em-
ployees of the corporation as the in-
terests and business of same may
require; any of the Directors shall
have the right to appoint, by written
instrument, another Director as an
proxy, to act in his stead, at any an-
nual meetings of the Board of Di-
rectors.
