ORDINANCE NO. 78.
An ordinance prohibiting any per-
son, corporation, firm or in-
dividual from placing or allow-
ing to remain upon any side-
walk or banquet of the Town
of Covington, La., any goods,
wares, merchandise, vegetables,
fruits, crates, boxes, or any
other obstruction, total or par-
tial, for the purpose of display
or sale, or any other purpose,
and providing a penalty for the
violation thereof.

Section One. Be it ordained by the
Town Council of the Town of
Covington, La., in legal session
convened, that from and after the pas-
sage of this ordinance, it shall be un-
lawful, and it is hereby expressly
prohibited for any person, corpora-
tion, firm or individual to place, or
permit to remain upon any sidewalk
or banquet in said Town of Cov-
ington, any goods, wares, merchan-
dise, vegetables, fruits, crates, boxes
or any other obstruction, total or
partial, for the purpose of display or
sale, or any other purpose.

Section Two. Be it further or-
dained, etc., That any person, cor-
poration, firm or individual violating
the provisions of this ordinance,
shall upon trial and conviction there-
of, be fined not more than fifty dol-
lars, nor less than five dollars, or be
imprisoned in the Town Jail for a
period of not longer than twenty
days, or both, at the discretion of
the Court.

Section Three. Be it further or-
dained, etc., That this ordinance
shall become effective immediately
on its passage.

franchise.

Whereas, due notice has been given
according to law for the sale of
a franchise for the operation of a
ferry for carrying freight and pas-
sengers for hire across the Tch-
efuncta River within a radius of two
miles of the point where the Hoult-
ville Ferry is now being operated
by Ernest Guitteau; and,

Whereas, Ernest Guitteau was the
only bidder appearing for the pur-
pose of obtaining said franchise;
and,

Whereas, no other bids have been
received; now, therefore,

Be it ordained, That the Parish of
St. Tammany does hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the
said Ernest Guitteau, a resident of
St. Tammany parish, a franchise for
a period of ten years under which
grant the said Ernest Guitteau is
authorized to establish a ferry for
the carrying of freight and pas-
sengers for hire across the Tch-
efuncta River within a radius of two
miles of the point where the Hoult-
ville Ferry is now being operated
by Ernest Guitteau.

Be it further ordained, That it
shall be unlawful for any other per-
son to operate a ferry within a radi-
us of two miles of the point where
the above described ferry is now be-
ing operated.

rate of ferrage and toll to be charg-
ed thereon shall be as follows:

Children going to school, free.

estrans, 10c each way.

AMENDMENT TO CHARTER
of the
ST. TAMMANY CONSTRUCTION
COMPANY, INC.

United States of America, State of
Louisiana, Parish of
St. Tammany.

Be it known, that on this seventh
day of the month of March, in the
year of our Lord one thousand nine
hundred and twenty-one, and of the
independence of the United States of
America the one hundred and forty-
fifth, before me, Lewis L. Morgan,
a Notary Public, duly commissioned
and sworn in and for the Parish of
St. Tammany, therein residing,
and in the presence of the witnesses
hereinafter named and undersigned,
personally came and appeared R. S.
Daniel and Fernando Estopinal,
both residents of the Parish of St.
Tammany, who declare that a gen-
eral meeting of the stockholders of
the St. Tammany Construction Com-
pany, Incorporated, was held at its
office in the Town of Covington, Lou-
isiana, on the 5th day of March,
1921, for the purpose of amending
Article One of its charter, of which
meeting due and legal notice was
given in accordance with the re-
quirements of its charter and the
laws of the State of Louisiana.

And appears further declare that
at said stockholders' meeting of the
St. Tammany Construction Company,
Incorporated, Article One of its char-
ter of incorporation was amended and
renewed so as to read as follows:

ARTICLE ONE.
