

**KRAJEWSKI CANE CRUSHER**

**GOOD HEALTH.**  
A French Notion For Correcting the Position of the Forehead.

A dextrous French fash is that of growing hair along the forehead of women with whom nature has been cruel in arranging for the hair to grow too far back on the forehead or where the hair springs in an ugly, irregular line.
