THE LAST PROTEST. The gist of the last protest of Japan, according to the Mainichi, is said to be as follows: "As the annexation of Hawaii by the United States is inimical to the maintenance of the existing peace in the Pacific, Japan must do all in her power for the independence of Hawaii. Japan, therefore, desires to fully enter into negotiations in the matter with the United States irrespective of the attitude of the Senate in order to obtain the necessary guarantee from America not only for the present, but for the future."

MONEY IN THE WATER BUSINESS. It is still very dry on the island of Hawaii. The steamers carry water for domestic purposes to Paauhau and other points on the Hamakua coast. Water is being searched for in the valleys and gulches and is bringing from 5 to 15 cents a gallon.
