**MONSTER RAFT PUT TO SEA**

AN ORIGINAL AND VERY DARING EXPERIMENT.

Five Million Feet of Lumber Being Towed From Portland to San Francisco—Takes the Place of the Steamships.

Island shipping men are eager to learn whether a monster raft which was put to sea at Portland with five million feet of lumber some little time ago, has reached San Francisco. The enterprise is original and daring and will attract attention all over the entire world. The huge raft is 296 feet long and 53 feet wide.

It is difficult to realize the immense quantity of material represented by these little figures, although a comparative idea may be gained by considering the fact that the largest ocean vessels seen in Honolulu harbor have an average capacity of little over one million feet. The contents of this one raft, if cut into inch boards and laid end to end would make a foot walk from New York to Chicago, with enough over to build several houses at either end.

The idea originated in the fertile brain of John Poulsen, of Inman, Poulsen & Co., whose attention was attracted to the subject by the difficulty of engaging vessels to take lumber to San Francisco to supply the extensive yard jointly operated in that city by the concern of which he is a member, and the North Pacific Lumber company, also of Portland.

Rafts of piling and spars have for several seasons past been put to sea and towed from the Columbia to the Golden Gate, but nothing like the undertaking now on foot has ever been attempted. Poulsen has drawn his designs from a scientific standpoint, and after careful consideration of all the difficulties to be encountered, so that it will be practically impossible for the lumber to become dislodged.

An ocean trip of 800 miles necessitates the strongest method of construction. The raft projects very little above the surface of the water and this greatly increases the chances of its making a safe trip, as the waves will wash completely over it, encountering little resistance and expending their force in battering it to pieces. This is a principle used in the construction of the famous whalebacks, and one which experience has demonstrated to be correct. If seen from a distance at sea the raft would more than likely be classified as a monster of the deep than as a great freight carrier.

**AN AUTOMATIC SUNSHADE.**  
This is a Berlin novelty. A U-tube partially filled with mercury, is connected with a bulb containing black wool and one containing air, and as the sun shines the absorption of the rays by the black wool causes the mercury to rise in the opposite side of the tube, closing the circuit of a motor that lets down the blind. When the sun is not out the mercury is level in the two tubes, closing a current that winds up the blind.
