HAMAKUA NEWS NUGGETS

THIS DRY DISTRICT DELUGED BY RAINS.

The New Road Leading Out of Maulua Nearing Completion—Callings Taken from the Hilo Tribune.

C. Plummer, the harness and saddle maker, is now established at Honokaa.

A. Louissou is back in Hamakua, his old stamping ground. Manager Forbes and family of Kukuhae, expect to visit Scotland in the summer.

The Iwalani was off Hamakua the past two weeks unable to discharge any freight, owing to incessant stormy weather along the coast.

The Hamakua portion of the Ooala gulch new road is nearing completion. When this cut is finished people will be able to drive from Maulua to Kawaihae or Mahukoua.

M. V. Holmes of Honokaa has a very pleasant smile on his face when asked as to the success of the Hamakua Soda Works, of which H. Hitchcock is the manager. They have an inexhaustible supply of fresh water.

The new Ahualoa school, back of Honokaa village, has been lately completed. The school has three rooms and now houses over 150 children from the homesteads. Mrs. Estep, assisted by two other teachers, is in charge. This school is independent of the one in town, which has about an equal number of pupils.

Panauhau and Paauilo are now joined, the last field having been cleared and is ready to plant by the former plantation. Paauilo and Kukaiaua are also joined and can only expand mountainward. There is only a strip left unutilized between Honokaa and Kukuhae and this Manager Forbes of the latter place says will be under cultivation in a year or so.

R. T. Rickard, the inventor of the Rickard patent coffee pulper, the other day at Honokaa pulped 78 pounds of berries in nine minutes. Fifteen machines have already been sold in Hamakua and Kona. Mr. Rickard had a number come down from the Coast by the Roderick Dhu, to be set up and sold in Hilo by W. Conradt, his agent.

HOMESTEADERS PETITION.

Puna Landholders Will Ask for Several Branch Roads. William Goudie of Puna while in Hilo last week had a petition drawn up in English and Hawaiian, which will be signed by the homesteaders of Nanawale and Kaohoe and by others, who are desirous of taking up lands on those homesteads, if there were any roads leading to them, says the Hilo Tribune. The petition states that those living on the lands of Nanawale took them up with the understanding that a road should be built. The lands of Kaohoe although fertile and valuable for coffee growing have not been taken up as rapidly as they would otherwise on account of the lack of road connections. If the road is built, Mr. Goudie says he will keep it in repair at his own expense. The petition will be presented to the Legislature at the next session.
