BRIGHT COFFEE OUTLOOK

COMMISSIONER MARSDEN TALKS
OF HIS TRIP.

Found No Pests or Blight in the Dis-
tricts Visited—Troubles Reported
From Punt Easily Remedied.

Commissioner of Agriculture Marsden and Government Entomologist Koebele came back on Saturday from a month spent in Hawaii with the most satisfactory assurances to the coffee planters. They did not find in all the districts they visited the presence of a single blight or pest in the coffee trees. The cause of the withering and dropping of leaves on some plantations, which had been reported to the department, with the fear that it was caused by some pest or blight, was found to be due to improper handling in transferring from the nursery to the plantation, and to careless planting. In every case where a tree was found to be dropping its leaves and withering, it was found that the tap root had been cut or injured in transplanting. The coffee tree is sensitive to injuries to the tap root. But in some of the new coffee planting districts visited, this fact was either unknown or overlooked, resulting in a loss and temporary discouragement to the planters.

"Entomologically," said Professor Koebele, "our trip was uninteresting. We found no new pests or blights. I found the Japanese beetle very abundant on one side of Hilo. The Catholic Mission school there, besides a number of individuals, have undertaken to distribute the fungus inoculated beetles, so that it is to be hoped the new plague will be of short duration."

LAHAINA NOTES.

A Canoe Capsizes—Politics and Whalers.

About noon on Tuesday two great whales passed Lahaina swimming to the northwest. They came inside of the buoy off Lahaina landing. A few nights ago a fishing canoe with a crew of three South Sea Islanders capsized outside the reef. The men all swam to the shore and left the canoe to its fate. The next morning shortly after daylight they found the boat, uninjured, off the breakwater, just outside the reef.

Senator H. P. Baldwin and Representative W. F. Pogue, who were passengers for Maalaea by the Mauna Loa were on the wharf here for a short time yesterday evening. Who is to be elected to fill the vacant place in the Senate appeared to be the theme of their conversation.

The Mauna Loa had a rough trip up and was rather late in getting here yesterday.

The Bennington arrived last night. Today she has been almost out of sight between Lanai and Kahoolawe, firing her heavy guns.
