SOME BIG UNIVERSITIES

RELATIVE SIZE OF DIFFERENT INSTITUTIONS.

Harvard Stands Ninth in the List of the World's Great Schools for Higher Education.

According to the seventh annual number of the Minerva, the Trubner catalogue of schools and universities of the world, the eight largest universities are those of Paris, Berlin, Vienna, Madrid, Naples, Moscow, Budapest and Munich, in the old world; Harvard, the largest American university, ranking in the ninth place. Comparison of the relative position of American universities shows, according to this work, that Harvard has risen in the course of the last ten years, from tenth to the ninth place, the University of Michigan from the eighteenth to the seventeenth, the University of Pennsylvania from the twenty-first to the twentieth, Minnesota from the twenty-third, California from the twenty-eighth to the twenty-fifth, Columbia from the thirty-third to the thirty-first, Chicago from the thirty-fifth to the twenty-eighth, Nebraska from the forty-fifth to the forty-first, while the University of the city of New York has dropped from the forty-ninth to the sixty-first, and the Washington University of St. Louis from the forty-seventh to the fifty-first.

The University of Paris exceeds all others in number of students, the register showing 11,000 last year. Berlin follows with 9,029; Vienna, 7,026; Madrid, 6,143; Naples, 5,103; Moscow, 4,461. Harvard, with 3,674 students, is the ninth in the list, but exceeds all other American universities, Oxford had 3,365, and Cambridge, 2,929 students. Edinburgh leads the Scotch list, with a roll of 2,850.

CONTRACTS AWARDED.

Board of Health Acts on a Number of Matters.

At a meeting of the Board of Health yesterday afternoon the contract for supplying beef cattle for six months at the Mokai settlement was awarded to the Trustees of the Parker Estate at their bid of five cents per pound dressed.

The contract to supply vaccine virus tubes was awarded to Benson, Smith & Co., Ltd., at 49c cents, a considerable reduction on the former contract.

It was reported that there is now no government physician in the Kau district, Dr. Capron having left, and Dr. McMillan acting for the plantations only. This led to the suggestion that notice be given that hereafter the purchase of a practice including the post of Government physician would not meet the approval of the Board.

The death of twenty-three persons unattended during March was reported to the Board.

The Maternity Home reported the investment of \$1,000 in the bonds of the Oahu Railway and Land Company.
