WILCOX ON GENEALOGY

COMPARE RANK OF QUEEN EMMA AND THE EX-QUEEN.

Liliuokalani's Strictures in Her Recent Book Set the Hawaiian Genealogist Considering the Historic Past. Editor Star: To undertake the task of defending the lamented Queen Emma Kaleleoualani's rank is not an enviable one, because you may touch the weak spot of some one unintentionally; therefore, I beg pardon of all the allies living. I am writing these lines solely in defense of the late Queen Emma Kaleleoualani's rank from the undignified and uncalled for attacks of Queen Liliuokalani.

The most tabued and exalted chiefs belong to the Maui family of chiefs, such as Kaakaaianini of East Maui; her rank was pooholewa i ka la (the rays of the sun were forbidden to shine on her head). King Kamehamehanu, King Kahakili and their sister Kalola, wife of King Kalaniloa of Hawaii, all had the niuipio rank. On this account, King Liholiho, Kamehameha II and King Kamehameha III were considered higher in blue blood than all the other Kamehamehas, through their mother's side, Keopulani, grandniece of King Kahakili. And Kamehameha I had the next rank, waha, a degree lower, but becoming a conqueror and a ruler, and a husband of the highest chiefess in blood living, he had conquered all.

As far as Queen Emma's claim as royal candidate for the throne in 1874, I say she had an equal claim with her opponent, the late King Kalakaua.

And now to compare their rank by their genealogies, and how many of their ancestors were kings and queens and how near they connected to Kamehameha the Great, let the public decide for themselves from the following genealogies:

Genealogy of Queen Emma Kaleleoualani, by S. M. Kamakau: Keaweikēkēhāliiokamoku married Lonomaikaika, to whom Kalaninuiamamao was born. He married Ahia, to whom Kunuialeimoku was born. He married Kaniinokalani, to whom Kalkookalani was born. She married Keliimāikai, to whom Kuaonānaha was born. She married John Young, Sr., to whom was born Fanny Kekela, John Young, Jr., and Jane Lāhilihi. Fannie Kekela married G. Naea. Their daughter was Emma Kaleleoualani. Jane Lāhilihi married A. Kaeo, to whom the present Albert K. Kūniākea was born.

Keaweikēkēhāliiokamoku also married Kalanikauleleiaiwi, to whom was born Keaumokunui. He married Kamakaimoku, to whom Keoua was born. He married Kekūiāpōiwa II, to whom was born Kamehameha I and Keliimāikai. The latter married Kalkookalani, to whom Kuaonānaha was born. She was the wife of John Young, Sr., and the ancestor through Fanny Kekela of Queen Emma, and through Jane Lāhilihi of Albert K. Kūniākea, as shown above.

Of course there is a dispute about the true father of Kuaonānaha, some genealogists claimed the true father was Kaleipāhala, a son of King Kalaniloa. But Kamehameha IV confirmed that the true father was Keliimāikai. Even Kaleipāhala's father was claimed to be King Keawenāuhili of Hilo, Hawaii. The Hawaiian historian, S. M. Kamakau, always claimed that Keliimāikai, brother of Kamehameha I was the true father of Kuaonānaha.

Genealogy of Liliuokalani, by J. K. Unuana: Keaweikēkēhāliiokamoku married Lonomaikaika, to whom was born Kalaninuiamamao. He married Kapāhā-Ahu, to whom Kaolaniālii was born. She married Kalaninuiamamao, to whom Alapaiwahine was born. She married Keopulani, to whom Kāmanawa was born. He married Kamokūiki, to whom Kapanānaha was born. He married Keohakaloie, to whom was born King Kalakaua, Queen Liliuokalani and Princess Likelike. A. S. Cleghorn married Princess Likelike, to whom was born Princess Victoria Kaiulani.

Keaweikēkēhāliiokamoku and Kalanikauleleiaiwi were king and queen for the whole Island of Hawaii; their son Keaumokunui, grandfather of Kamehameha I, was king of Kohala and Kona. Kalaninuiamamao was the king of Kau and Puna. All the Kamehamehas were descendants of the Great House of Keona. King Lunalilo also a descendant of the same house. The only representatives living of this great house are: High Chiefess Eliabeth Kekaantau and her niece Teresa Owana Kaohela-lani, and also Prince Albert Kūka'ilimoku Kūniākea, cousin of the late Queen Emma Kaleleoualani. The Kalakaua ancestors were celebrated as the great councillors of Kamehameha the Great in his struggle of uniting the Islands into one Kingdom.
