NEW PACIFIC MAIL BOATS

TWO OF LARGE SIZE HAVE BEEN ORDERED. They Will Take the Places of the Peking and Rio—Will be Built at Newport News.

SAN FRANCISCO, December 23.—The Pacific Mail Steamship Company has given orders for the construction of two new steamers to ply between this port and Yokohama and Hongkong.

At the present time the Pacific Mail has three steamers in its Oriental service—namely, the China, Peking and Rio de Janeiro. The two new vessels will take the place of the Rio de Janeiro. The three vessels are run in a joint service with three of the Occidental and Oriental Company's vessels and three new ships of Sachiyo Asano's Japanese Company.
