

A VALUABLE IMPORTATION FROM HAWAII. Distinguished Officials Gather to Greet a Long-eared Pet That Has Yet to be Trained.

"Have you seen Stratemeyer's donkey?" was the question on every tongue today in the various offices at the custom house. The donkey came on the Mauna Loa and after a trip up town to get clipped he was led to the custom house yesterday by janitor Brown, creating a sensation all the way along Fort street. He was placed in the large enclosure behind the custom house, where he received visitors all day. When he arrived at the custom house, Collector-General Stackable, Deputy Scott and a score of clerks, inspectors and other officials were leaning out of windows to catch a glimpse of the long-eared pet. The donkey came from Hawaii, in some parts of which island his kind are as plentiful as jackrabbits in Australia. He is a pet for the surveyor's son and was supposed to be a well-behaved donkey, broken in to riding and driving. But he is not. Mr. Stratemeyer is looking for some one who will do the breaking in. He says he wants someone who will be kind and not ruffle the animal's disposition, for he declares that when a donkey's temper is once spoiled, he declines to make friends with any one and even uses violence in rejecting friendly advances. The port surveyor took many friends in to look at the new arrival and all were enthusiastic in praise of its appearance. It is a pretty little donkey, with head and ears big enough for a very large mule. No one went very near it.
