MAY ALL BE SENT BACK PASSENGERS WHO LEFT HERE ON THE KINAU. Over Two Hundred Japanese on Her Deck—Landing Will Probably be Refused.

The island steamship Kinau, which left port yesterday just as the Board of Health was making its order for the Wilder and Inter-Island Steamship companies to allow no more vessels to depart until further notice, carried a large number of Japanese immigrants and a deck full of Japanese immigrants. There were 270 deck passengers on the boat, most of them Japanese immigrants who are booked to work on plantations.

It is considered very doubtful that Kinau will succeed in making a landing at more than one Hawaii port. She is quite likely to show up here in a day or so with nearly all her passengers and freight still on board, as the people of Hawaii are likely to keep her away as long as they learn that she left here after the plague had been officially declared to be here. The first port at which the Kinau calls on Hawaii is Kawaihau. From here telephones run all over the island. The news that the black plague is in Honolulu will undoubtedly get ashore immediately when the vessel reaches Kawaihau and when the Kinau reaches Hilo and other ports she is likely to get a lively reception.
