There were eighteen different kinds of work to bid on separately. Match's bid consisted of separate bids for each of these items, but with the stipulation in the bid that it was conditioned on being awarded the whole contract. The total of the bid was \$325,604. The Hawaiian Electric Company bid on the electrical work and England on the plumbing.

Captain Humphrey has not yet been advised as to what bids were received at the other points where bids were received. It is probable however that numerous bids were received, at them. The specifications have been here for so short a time that local bidders have had very little time to study them and make their estimates. The Hawaiian-American Engineering and Construction Company put in its bid at San Francisco through Mr. Amweg. The work under these bids must begin before July 1 or the appropriation will lapse.

MONGOLIA WILL NOT ENTER THE HARBOR

H. HACKFELD AND CO. ADVISED BY CABLE THAT THE VESSEL WILL LIE OUTSIDE.

The S. S. Mongolia will not enter the harbor tomorrow on her arrival from San Francisco. The big vessel is so deep with freight that Manager Schwerin decided she could not come into this port. She will lie outside and the passengers will be brought ashore in launches and probably by the tug Fearless. The vessel will probably bring a good sized crowd of passengers to this place as a number of Asiatics will depart on her for the Orient. She will bring six days later mail. The vessel probably resume her voyage to the Orient in the evening. She is due tomorrow morning.

SITE SELECTED FOR LABORATORY

WORK FOR STUDY OF LEPROSY AT MOLOKAI WILL BE UNDERTAKEN AT AN EARLY DATE.

Surgeon General Wyman, U. S. M. H. Service, returned on Saturday night from Molokai, whither he had been with President Pinkham of the Board of Health for the purpose of selecting a site for the United States research station. He stated that it had been decided to mark off the necessary square mile just east of the Baldwin Home at Kalawao. Four of the Territorial staff were left at Molokai to mark out the land. The spot selected is well drained and has an excellent water supply. It slopes gently up from the sea towards the pail.

General Wyman and the party made the trip on the steamer Likelike which left here on Friday night. He made a thorough inspection of the leper settlement which he pronounced to be in splendid condition and declared that it presented the best possible field for research into leprosy. The party were serenaded by the settlement band and had luncheon with Superintendent McVeigh. The return trip was made in excellent time. It is understood that the section of land selected will be turned over to the United States at the earliest possible moment so that the appropriation of Congress for the establishment of the hospital and laboratory may be available.

FERN MAY LEAVES CIVIC TICKET

PROMISED THE REPUBLICAN CONVENTION HE WOULD ABIDE BY ITS DECISION.

Fern was a candidate for supervisor before the Republican convention. As such he rose in the convention and formally pledged himself to abide by the decision of the convention as to whether he should run or not. Just as Clarence Crabbe promised the convention that if it did not choose him he would support A. M. Brown and as Brown promised that if he was not chosen he would support Crabbe, Fern followed the rule and pledged himself to stand as a supporter of whomsoever the convention named. The Civic Federation's politicians apparently persuaded him to break his promise, but there are reports that he will reconsider his action and withdraw.
