Hawaiian standard time is 10 hours 30 minutes slower than Greenwich time, being that of the meridian of 157 degrees 30 minutes. The time whistle blows at 1:30 p. m., which is the same as Greenwich, 9 hours, 0 minutes. The Sun and Moon are for local time for the whole group.

Average for the month, 0.98 inches.  
Average number of days with .01 of an inch or more, 14.  
The greatest monthly precipitation was 2.40 inches in 1885.  
The least monthly precipitation was 0.24 inches in 1877.  
The greatest amount of precipitation recorded in any 24 consecutive hours was 0.81 inches on June 22, 1885.

Average number of clear days, 13; partly cloudy days 15; cloudy days, 2.  
Wind. (1875-1904.)
