Judge De Bolt Saturday denied a motion for a new trial of the case of Harold Jeffs against the Rapid Transit Company, in which he gave defendant a judgment for \$100 several days ago. The motion was filed by Castle & Withington, and was based on a claim that the decision was contrary to the evidence and the law. Exceptions were filed, and an appeal taken to the Supreme Court.
