DE KNIGHT IN HONOLULU AGAIN

QUEEN LILIUOKALANI'S ATTORNEY COULD NOT RESIST THE CHANCE OF ANOTHER VISIT.

Clarence W. De Knight of Washington, D. C., is at present in the city, having arrived on the Sonoma Wednesday and naturally enough his arrival created considerable interest in view of the fact that he has been the attorney for Queen Liliuokalani in her claim to the crown lands.

"My visit here to Honolulu this time is simply one for relaxation," he said this morning. "I was here about three years ago and ever since then I have had a hankering to get back here for another trip. There is an indefinable charm about Hawaii which seems hard for me to express in words. I have heard many men say this and so I do not claim any originality for it, but I feel it just the same.

"Oddly enough I half expected to be disappointed, but so far from that, I am more delighted than ever. You know how it is when one revisits a place, very often the first charm disappears, but the contrary is the case with Hawaii. I was in San Francisco on a visit and found that I had a chance

to take a run down here. I simply jumped at the chance—and here I am. "No. My trip does not concern the claim of Queen Liliuokalani at all, though of course I shall pay my respects to Her Majesty at as early a time as permissible. I do not care to discuss the case at all as that is a matter simply between client and lawyer, while what has already transpired is a matter of record."

De Knight will return on the S. S. Sierra.
