DE WITTE AND THE PREMIERSHIP.

ST. PETERSBURG, October 25.—Count de Witte has informed the Emperor that he will accept the premiership unless he is to be made a mere figurehead. He proposes to extend the Douma along western lines, to broaden the suffrage and complete the freedom of the press.
