McCandless For The Senate

L. L. McCandless for senator from this Island ought to receive the hearty support of every voter regardless of party. McCandless has two qualities, which, added to honesty and ability, make the desirable legislator— independence and energy.

It may indicate how much truth there is in these wholesale charges of corruption and may explain why it was that the spirit of the first few weeks, a spirit of union, of mutual sympathy and determination to drop political antagonism and work only to save the city, has gradually given way to one of bitter inharmoniousness than ever existed before and to one in which criminal charges of corruption in office, which before April 18 would have staggered the city, seem to attract comparatively little attention and, are, with accounts of crimes in public streets, the principal features of the daily news furnished by the city's papers.
