The Tehuantepec Route To The East

The sailing of the S. S. Arizona last Monday evening inaugurates a new route by which the sugar product of these Islands will reach market.

The Tehuantepec National Railroad, crossing the isthmus from which it derives its name, was built originally by the Mexican Government.

The Tehuantepec railroad is 130 miles in length and runs through a comparatively level and fertile country, the grade at no part exceeding 2 per cent.

General Kuropatkin

The cable dispatches a few days ago announced that the Russian Government had seized the manuscript of General Kuropatkin's history of the war between Russia and Japan.

General Kuropatkin is the one general officer of the Russian military and naval forces who emerged from the war with a reputation unshattered.

It is true that General Stoessel who surrendered Port Arthur was the recipient of all kinds of honors and compliments at the hands of the Japanese, and was complimented to the skies for his brave defense of the beleaguered fortress.

In spite of the "luring on" strategy announced by Kuropatkin, and at which he doubtless smiled as much as anybody, Kuropatkin displayed military ability of a high order.

The "On to Richmond" cry in our own civil war, and the stubborn but ill-adviced orders of the Empress Eugenie in the Franco-Prussian war, furnish examples of the hindrance which a fixed sentiment at home, ignorant and impatient of the exigencies and necessities of the conditions in the field, can be to capable commanders.

He recognized the utter rottenness of the Russian army and the system that made it what it was. He was brave enough and great enough to tell his government the truth about it, so far as telling the truth under the circumstances could be and of any avail to bring about better conditions.


But accepting conditions as they were he showed a grasp and command of the forces under him and the conditions that confronted him, that places him in all but the highest rank of military commanders.

If Russia had any of the recuperative and reserve power of a great nation, Kuropatkin's campaign in Manchuria was of the kind to have enabled her to bring it to bear.

He seems to be a man of convictions and honesty with military ability of a high, though not of the highest order, and a patriotism rare in Russia, a real desire to recognize the national shortcomings and needs and to rectify and supply them.

MANY WERE CALLED BUT FEW CHOSEN

ATTORNEY GENERAL PETERS WAS IN FACT, THE ONLY ONE TO GET A HOLT WILL CASE FEE.

Attorney General Peters today was awarded a very handsome fee by Judge Robinson for services in the construction of the Holt will case. The court allowed Peters who had represented James L. Holt, Jr., the sum of \$1,000. All of the applications for fees made by other attorneys were denied.

Judge Lindsay has made an order dissolving the injunction obtained by H. C. Middleitch for the C. F. Herrick Carriage Company Ltd., a bankrupt concern, to prevent Kuluo Kulaniansole from disposing of any shares in the Kapoleian Estate, Ltd., until the settlement of a certain claim by the carriage company had been liquidated.

The court further granted Kulaniansole \$100 as counsel fees and costs and made an order that the plaintiff could now begin no further proceedings against Kuluo until 3 days after this allowance had been paid, and it was further ordered that the defendant need not make any answer to any proceedings that might be brought until after the payment of the \$100.

Judge De Bolt today overruled the plea made by the certain heirs in the Barata estate case denying the jurisdiction of the court in the matter. The court said that it would be an excellent thing if litigation in this case could be stopped, so that some settlement of the estate could be effected.
