Times of the tide was taken from the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey tables. The tides at Kahului and Hilo occur about one hour earlier than at Honolulu. Hawaiian standard time is 10 hours 30 minutes slower than Greenwich time, being that of the meridian of 157 degrees 40 minutes. The time whistle blows at 1:30 p. m., which is the same as Greenwich, 6 hours, 0 minutes. The Sun and Moon are for local time for the whole group.

U. S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE-WEATHER BUREAU.

The following data, covering a period of 32 years, have been compiled from the Weather Bureau and McKibbin records at Honolulu, T. H. They are issued to show the conditions that have prevailed, during the month in question, for the above period of years, but must not be construed as a forecast of the weather conditions for the coming month.

The warmest month was that of 1897, with an average of 74°
The coldest month was that of 1903, with an average of 67°
The highest temperature was 82° on February 17, 1890; February 16, 1897 and February 25, 1906.
The lowest temperature was 52° on February 15, 1922.
PRECIPITATION (rain 1877-1894, and 1905-6.)
Average for the month, 4.52 inches.
Average number of days with .01 of an inch or more, 12.
The greatest monthly precipitation was 14.90 inches in 1893.
The least monthly precipitation was 0.26 inches in 1906.
The greatest amount of precipitation recorded in any 24 consecutive hours was 8.65 inches on February 27, 1888.

HARRIMAN AND HIS HOLDINGS.
NEW YORK, February 26.—E. H. Harriman has refused to inform the railroad commission as to the extent of his individual holdings.
NO PHILIPPINE TORNADO.
MANILA, February 26.—The report of a tornado in the Philippines is untrue.
MEXICAN REVOLUTION CAUGHT.
EL PASO, Tex., February 26.—Gen. Villarreal, the Mexican revolutionist who escaped jail at Managua and went to San Marcos de Colon, has been captured by the Nicaraguans.
SENATE APPROPRIATIONS.
WASHINGTON, February 26.—The Senate has passed the agricultural bill, carrying \$10,000,000; the postoffice bill, \$210,000,000 and the pension bill, \$145,000,000. The measure establishing an agricultural bank in the Philippines also passed.
SUB-SOCIAL NOTES.
Mr. Ah Cheong, who has had nothing to occupy him for a long time, moved to High Sheriff Henry's resort on the reef this morning, where he will remain until about the middle of August. His means of support have not been visible.
A party of half a dozen Japanese gentlemen and four Celestials called on District Judge Whitney this morning. Having heard that they had been engaging in games of chance, the court thought a collection, for the benefit of the Territory is order. The Japanese guests each contributed six dollars and expenses while the Chinese each gave \$4 and costs.

Judge Lindsay yesterday signed a decree permitting the adoption of Lavinia Rickard by Peter Johnson.

Judge Lindsay granted letters of administration yesterday, to Cecil Brown on the estate of Elizabeth Wright, under a bond of \$5,000.
