HOMESTEAD LOTS FOR SETTLEMENT

PLANS FOR OFFERING A NUMBER OF LOTS, AS A RESULT OF FREAR'S TRIP.

One of the results of the trip to Hawaii made by Governor Frear two weeks ago will be the opening of a number of homestead lots for settlement. Part of the land mentioned is in the district near Waiohine, Kau, and the rest near Waimea. The first-mentioned tract was applied for under a settlement association proposition about six months ago by nineteen citizens who desired about 600 acres of land apiece. They were told that no more settlement associations would be given land, but that all individual applications would be looked into. While in Kau recently a meeting was held at which the applicants talked over the matter with Governor Frear and Land Commissioner Pratt. It was not decided at this meeting whether the lease or the special agreement proposition would be best nor was the area decided on. The would-be homesteaders are all old Hawaiians who state that they have lost or sold the property that they used to own and want some place where they can grow a few sweet potatoes, raise a few pigs and a couple of head of stock. They will be dependent on the local market for the sale of their produce but want a home, some place where they can live quietly on their own land, instead of paying rent as they do now.

At Waimea, Hawaii, the matter is very different. There land is wanted by the cowboys who work on the Parker ranch. All they desire is a place where they can put up a house, have a little vegetable garden, raise a little corn and have enough pastures for a couple of saddle ponies. From three to five acres of land apiece is all that they desire and about 900 acres fit for just this, is owned by the Government. The larger plots will be further back, while the land close in near Akona's, which is richer and better, will be sold in small plots.

BRECKONS' INVESTIGATOR

According to the letters received from Wilbur F. Craft by E. W. Thwing, of this city, the special investigator of the charges made by the clergyman against U. S. District Attorney Breckons should have arrived in this city yesterday. As there was no steamer due then and he did not come the day before by the America Maru, there is a possibility that he may arrive on the Lurline, due here from San Francisco tomorrow. His name seems to be unknown here and the only knowledge that he might arrive has come through the source indicated.
