When from the midst of this seething cauldron sprung these fiery fountains of molten lava it was a great sight as higher and higher they went, larger and larger they grew, brilliant and more brilliant they shone; and at last flew together in one grand conflagration, and with a great noise, and with a force that seemed to shake the whole mountain.

To say that I was amazed and not a little frightened at this wonderful and unearthly sight, is not to be wondered at, for the display surpassed anything that I had ever heard or read regarding any former eruption. And though I was too much surprised to realize the full significance of this wonderful display, I remember it was a scene of unparalleled brilliancy, indescribable magnificence and unapproachable grandeur.

MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE

FUKUDA TETSUJI FOUND GUILTY OF MURDERING SUGHEYOKA—SURPRISE AT VERDICT.

HILO, December 18.—After a long trial, which on the whole was painstaking and thorough, despite the unfortunate interruption owing to illness, Fukuda Tetsuji was on Friday last found guilty of murder in the second degree. The prosecution was conducted by Deputy Attorney-General Larnach, assisted by County Attorney Williams and his deputy, while the defense, at the request of the court, was undertaken by H. Irwin and W. H. Smith.


