

## PERPETUAL INJUNCTION

Judge Robinson yesterday granted a perpetual injunction in favor of Ching Tam Shee, executrix of the will of C. Winam, against Oriental Life Insurance Co., Ltd., and Charles H. Rose, deputy sheriff of Honolulu. It restrains the defendants from selling certain real property belonging in his lifetime to Winam, a once wealthy Chinese merchant and rice planter whose affairs were involved heavily with debt at his death. The appointed sale thus stopped was to be under an execution issued out of the Circuit Court on August 2, 1909. In the meantime the executrix won an appeal to the Supreme Court, and the present decree is in accordance with the appellate court's decision. The land on which execution is estopped comprises an area of 2.44 acres at Kalia, Waikiki, and 23 lots in Kapahu tract of 5000 square feet each.

**MRS. GOUVEIA WINS.**  
Mrs. Gouveia will receive the death benefit amounting to \$1270 or so from her late husband's membership in the Portuguese Mutual Benefit Society. Judge Whitney this morning directed a verdict in her favor against the claims of the children by her husband's first wife as well as her own represented by a guardian.

**COURT ITEMS.**  
The original submission on agreed facts, Simerson vs. Simerson, was argued and submitted before the Supreme Court today by C. F. Peterson and A. D. Larnach.

William W. Wright petitions that he be appointed guardian of Thomas Elliott, an insane person in the asylum, who has \$1937.86 in bank needing to be looked after.

With a heavy load of good things for Christmas aboard, the S. S. Alameda arrived this morning about 7:30 o'clock, having made the run from San Francisco in 5 days, 20 hours, 51 minutes, 14 seconds.

She brought 86 cabin passengers, 33 steerage passengers, 1560 tons of cargo, including eight automobiles; and 260 sacks of mail.

There is no change in the personnel of the officers with the exception that S. A. Shipman, formerly assistant engineer is now chief engineer aboard the popular ferry.

Among returned kamaainas were: A. J. Campbell, Churchill Harvey-Midger, J. D. Kennedy, and H. T. Moore.

The trip was a very pleasant one and the social features as plentiful and enjoyable as ever.

Purser Smith stated that the S. S. Sierra would probably be put on the run about the last of January and that the Alameda would continue on her regular schedule until then.


