## HAWAII AGAIN AS "INSULAR POSSESSION"

New York Journal of Commerce: An insecticide or fungicide is any substance or mixture of substances intended to be used for preventing, destroying, repelling or mitigating any insects or fungi in any environment whatsoever.  
Inquiries on the part of those interested may be addressed to the Insecticide and Fungicide Board, Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C., to whom application may be made for copies of the law and rules and regulations for its enforcement. The Insecticide and Fungicide Board, composed of four members selected from the scientific staff of the Bureau of Animal Industry, the Bureau of Plant Industry, the Bureau of Entomology and the Bureau of Chemistry, was organized by the secretary of agriculture to assist him in enforcing the provisions of the insecticide act of 1910 as provided by law, and has just issued Decision No. 1, relating to the subject of Insect powders.  
Sections 1 and 2 of the act are especially applicable to persons engaged in trade in the above articles in the territories and insular possessions of the United States, viz: Alaska, Arizona, Hawaii, New Mexico, Philippine Islands and Porto Rico, in view of the fact that the manufacture or sale of any adulterated or misbranded insecticide, paris green, lead, arsenate, or fungicide within the territories is punishable by fine or imprisonment.

### NEW POSTAL CARD AND REGISTRY STAMP

The Postmaster General has approved a new design for the two-cent foreign single postal card, which will be placed on sale about January 1, 1912. The subject of the stamp is a likeness of General U. S. Grant at the age of forty-seven, about a year after he became President. This portrait has been pronounced by General Frederick D. Grant an excellent likeness of his distinguished father. On the postal card the portrait appears within a frame, the inner lines of which form an ellipse, while the outer lines are rectangular, with inwardly curving corners. Above the portrait and following the curve of the ellipse are the words "U. S. Postal Card," and below is the name "Grant" in a curved ribbon. The denomination is expressed in words and numerals in the lower portion of the frame. The


words "Universal Postal Union, United States of America" appear in English and French in the upper left corner of the new card. The color of the card will be selected later.  
A special ten-cent registry stamp is also being prepared for both domestic and foreign postage; it will bear an engraving of an eagle with outstretched wings. It will also be ready about January 1, but it will still be permissible thereafter to use the ordinary stamp for registering letters and parcels.


