COMMERCIAL. With the return of the season, the buoyant, hopeful spirit pervading all classes, more especially those interested in the agricultural industries of the Islands.

The Consular flag of the Republic of Peru was hoisted at half mast on Thursday last, the 6th instant, in token of respect to the memory of the late General M. Pardo, Ex-President of Peru, and at the time of his untimely death President of the Senate of that Republic.
