SATURDAY, MAY 8. The Removal of Seward.

A dispatch from Washington states that the President has finally determined to relieve the country of the edium of being represented at the Court of China, by George F. Seward, and has requested that individual's official resignation. In case it is not rendered with becoming alacrity, the dishonored official will be removed without ceremony. Meantime, the settlement of his accounts with the State Department has been suspended.

The extraordinary deliberation with which this action has taken is equalled by the urgent necessity for it that has existed for years. Seward has been sojourning in the Orient for a very long period, first as Consul-General, at Shangbai, and then as United Sates Minister at Pekin, and so far as his personal interests are concerned, he has not

resided there in vain. From the first he appears to have keenly realized that his chief business in the Flowery Kingdom was his own aggrandize ment. Any incidental services he could render his Government have been cheerfully given, so long as they were not of a character to interfere with his own designs. He has been a resident of China for money making purposes exclusively, and seems to have regarded official position a mere auxiliary to the more essential object in view. In getting money, he has apparently exhausted every ordinary expedient known to disreputable public servants, and has ocassionally ventured upon acts the proper characterization of which would require a very prudent use of language. His administra-tion af affairs at shanghai and Pekin has had a tendency to bring discredit on the American name in every civilized court. About three years have elapsed since the Chro-nicle first directed the attention of the country to

his doings, and presented startling testimony against him. At the last session of Congress he was called home, and articles of impreachment were filed against him by the House Committee on Foreign Relations. During his examination by that committee he declined to produce his books on the disgraceful ground that they would criminate him. He escaped impreachment by a very close vote in the House of Representatives, and then, to the amazement of the country and foreign Governments, he was returnd to his distanguished post, branded with dishonor. The pitiable excuse was given that the State Department could not do without his services very well at that juncture. It is right that President Hayes should have concluded to remove him with the ring of Canaille, which has thrown so much disgrace upon the American name at the Chinese Capitol, we mean the renegade religious hypocrite, Rev. Christmas
Holcombe, Secretary of the United States LegaDouble Effect and Centrifugal Machines tion, formerly a sewing-machine agent in the wooden nutmeg State, the great American bum-mer, Francis P. Knights the honest receiver of the late Edwin Smith's Estate, and the Burmese convert, Chester Sebastopol Bradford Taylor, who parades himself as the United States Charg'd Affaires and Diplomatic adviser, thus adding

ridicule to the disgrace. California is interested in the matter particularly, for the reason that Seward is believed to have been largely concerned in stimulating coolie immigration to this coast, if he has not actually reaped a personal profit by the traffic. At any rate, his removal will excite general gratification on this coast, as well as throughout the country. He should not be removed, but he should be properly dealt with by the Government .- Chronicle




