Cass and Butler, 12,051 Taylor and Fillmore, 10,557 Van Buren and Adams, 990 Democratic maj. over whig vote, 1,494 Do do Free Soil, 10,925 Do do Whig and Free Soil, 368

In Potawatamie county the vote was, for Cass and Butler, 43; Taylor and Fillmore, 527 --vote excluded.

SANITARY RECOMMENDATIONS.--The authorities of Boston and Philadelphia, in contemplation of the approach of Asiatic cholera, have taken precautionary measures.

James T. Seyser, last week recovered a verdict of \$5,000 damages, against the city of Memphis, for injuries sustained by falling into a cistern, authorized to be dug by its agents, at the north-west corner of Main and Jefferson streets. The cistern was about twenty-five feet deep; and the plaintiff's thigh was fractured, and other injuries sustained.

Arey, which arrived at Boston on Saturday last, from Liverpool, brought over two immigrant passengers, young men, who stowed themselves on board at Liverpool, and remained hid five days before they made themselves known, having nothing to eat or drink during that time.

DIAMONDS DROV.--The late disturbances in the French capital, and other portions of the European continent, have had the effect of causing so large an influx into England of diamonds and other valuables, that they are now "a drug in the market," and nearly unobtainable except at a very depreciated rate.
