

BY AUTHORITY.  
The Democratic party in Wisconsin has been defeated, and seemingly routed, but I find in it no cause for despair, nor any feeling more than present regret. The reasons for this defeat are numerous and various, though the whigs will not, of course, recognize them as genuine or legitimate. In the first place, the storm was terrific, such as I never recall to have seen elsewhere. It was a greater number of our voters than Whigs; the latter lie nearer to the country towns and nearer to the polls. Many democrats are strenuously in favor of the one true principle: they consider it recommended by General Jackson, and as having received the extreme sanction of Mr. Polk. Many are opposed to the re-election of the General Commissioner, and among these, prominent and influential men, such as Senator Cameron, Governor Porter, and the numerous friends these gentlemen have. Governor Shuck had enemies in the party, and Foster was considered an ill candidate. Foster defeated, and in addition to this, Shuck was not a very popular man. In the second place, the very high and arduous election (Muhlenberg died suddenly a short time prior to the election) his appointments were chiefly of men who had been opposed to the nomination of Muhlenberg; hence a great dissatisfaction since existed with Gov. Shuck. In addition to this, he had been secretary of the commonwealth under Gov. Porter, and resigned upon a quarrel, so that Porter's influence was against him also.

To have elected the General Commissioner against such odds would have been almost miraculous. Even as it is, the majority will not be very large. But again, the vote was small, and I am convinced that the entire vote will not equal that given to Mr. Clay, and probably not so much more than the native difference. Besides the weather, to what is this owing? Our defeat produced by causes already stated, and undoubtedly by the tariff also. The Whigs, therefore, are to be congratulated, and surely the anti-tariff democrats had no inducement to vote for the re-election of men, such as Moses McLean, Richard Brothman, Dr. Leib, and others of the Pennsylvania delegation, whose election would have signally helped as the rebuke to the tariff. They had no interest to bring about the re-election of any of the candidates, and their opinion, and the only difference could have been tariff or no tariff. Where the tariff question was raised, the tariff of '46 succeeded.

Charles Brown, opposed to the tariff of '42, and against the re-election of the Whigs, in 1836, in consequence of his approval of the tariff of '46, is elected in a district which gave Mr. Clay over 1000 majority. Col. Florence, an open and ardent advocate of the tariff of '46 reduced the majority in his district from 1300 to 200, while C. J. Ingersoll, a tariff of '42 man, is elected by a somewhat reduced majority.

Manuport, a perfect Manchester of Lowell, containing nothing but factories and manufacturers, gives an increased democratic majority—because here the tariff matter was fairly canvassed, on open grounds, at public meetings attended by men, women and children. These are some of the reasons for this result, and I believe that what will come from it! Success and victory! "Like causes produce like effects," and here you have some past incidents for examples:

In 1820 the federalists elected Heister, Governor, but were routed at the polls by 20,000 Shuckites, the republican candidate. In 1824, in 1828, the republican candidate was elected out of about 100,000 votes. In 1832 Ritner was the Whig Governor, and the Whigs in like manner carried the whole Legislature—they reorganized the Legislature to suit themselves, but in 1836 the democracy carried the State and Adams was elected federal candidate, even came out democratic, defeating the notorious Thaddeus Stevens. In 1838 they fought us hard—it was the burkhar year, but Porter succeeded by some 7 or 8,000. In 1840 Harrison carried the State, but in 1841 Porter, with many enemies in the party, carried by 25,000 votes.
